Paper submission

The symposium will feature oral and poster presentations. Authors are invited to submit extended abstracts via electronicmail (isseep@chemeng.ugm.ac.id) or through www.isseep.com to ISSEEP secretariat that will be peer-reviewed. Those accepted for oral presentations are required to submit the full-paper version. The abstracts and full-papers will be included in the symposium proceeding.

The abstract, in MS word format not more than 1 page of A4 size paper, includes a maximum of 5 key-words and clearly indicates the purpose of the work, approach and results. The abstract(s) is in a single column with all margins of 2.5 cm, single space type written form and must include:

Full title of the paper (12-point font size, Times New Roman font)

Full names of the author and co-author(s) (12-point font size, Times New Roman font), and respective affiliation (10-point font size, Times New Roman font),

Telephone, fax and e-mail address of the corresponding author (10-point font size, Times New Roman font)

Main text (12-point font size, Times New Roman font)
