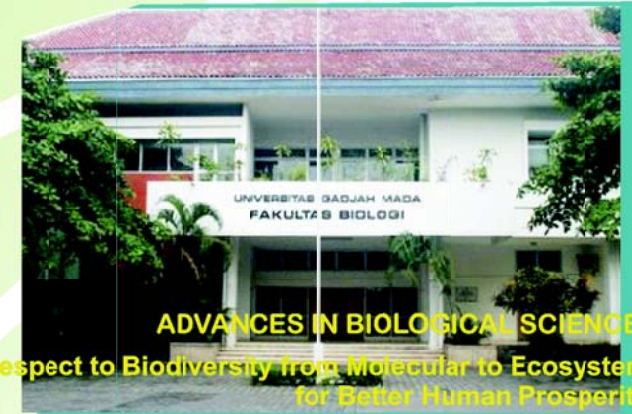

BACKGROUND

The world is facing multiple problems in biodiversity utilization and management as affected by the increase of human population, land degradation and deforestation along with inappropriate economics and development policies. One of critical problem is natural degradation that threatening biodiversity which is imperatively to be overcome. The global climate change is threatening at alarming rate due to the extinction of biological resources from gene to ecosystems. In line with those issues, a biological scientific program is needed to enhance strategic scientific linkage, multidisciplinary approach, partnership and collaboration of mutual benefit among biological scientists. For this purpose, International Conference on Biological Science will be conducted. Biology as a basic science contributes to the development of other applied sciences, such as agriculture, medicine, and pharmacy.
