"I just finished Zuhr prayer when I went out and saw balloons caught in the palm tree that have been somewhat deflated, stuck in a palm tree. Out of curiosity, I took the balloon using punting pole," said Rini, accompanied by her husband when she received the prize on Monday (19/9) at UGM Central Office.

She claimed to have never heard of balloons with prizes released at the Anniversary of UGM.
