"Asean Geography Student Conference is joined by Geography students from ASEAN universities that have passed selections on scientific papers. Thank God, we won the best presenter category," said Aditya Pradana at Faculty of Geography UGM on Friday (18/11).

Aditya Pradana, team chairman, said Universitas Gadjah Mada sent three teams to the AGSC with 12 members from Environmental Geography.

Aditya said the UGM team presented their paper themed "*Coastal Typology Mapping for Sustainable Coastal Development*" with Aji Purnomo being chairman. Another paper themed "*Water Balance Analysis to Combat Climate Change Impact*" is chaired by Alya Rasyida Zahra.
