Amount of 29 KKN PPM UGM students began to carry out community service activities in Temayang, Bojonegoro, East Java. The program started with an online UGM PPN KKN team reception event which was attended by the Bojonegoro Regent, Hj. Anna Mu'awanah, and the Heads of Service and Deputy Deans of the Academic and Student Affairs FKH UGM, drh. Agung Budiyanto, M.P., Ph.D.

Agung Budiyanto, in his remarks, conveyed that in the situation of the Covid-19 pandemic the implementation of the Community Service program must be conducted online. Even so, he hopes that this activity is not to discourage KKN PPM UGM Temayang students from undergoing community service.

"KKN students who are members of the Tim Sayang Temayang Siap Menyayangi Temayang will compile a Technopark-based of beef cattle region in Jono Village, Temayang District, Bojonegoro Regency, East Java," he said on Tuesday (6/30).

Besides, the students will also carry out various program activities to encounter New Normal online. These activities include manufacturing antiseptics and disinfectants from herbal ingredients, management strategies for livestock groups, MSMEs, cultural actors in dealing with the Covid-19 pandemic.
