UGM and Islamic Research and Training Institute (IRTI) have signed the cooperation deal at the Multimedia Room of Central Office of UGM on Friday (14/8). The cooperation letter was signed by UGM's Rector Prof Sudjarwadi and the Director of IRTI, Prof Bambang PS Brodjonegoro, witnessed by the Dean of Economics and Businesses Faculty (FEB) of UGM Prof Marwan Asri, IRTI and Islamic Development Bank representatives.
