

Handover of Cadastral Survey Students

UGM Geodesy Engineering department has just made cooperation with Timor Leste Government. In this cooperation, the two sides agreed to make serious effort in creating staff ready for work on cadastral survey by preparing professionals for land certification.

Dedi Atunggal S.P., S.T., M.Sc., a teaching staff of Geodesy Engineering explained that this cooperation was one of the efforts that will be continued in International Cooperation development. Geodesy Engineering held Course of Cadastral Survey for a number of Timor Leste Government employees.

“Specially, in this course the materials of land measurement principle and practice, computer based processing of cadastral data, land border re-measurement, and other important materials are taught to the participants,” He explained on Thursday (27/8).
