

Hundreds of Student Activists held Indonesian Students Conference (KMI) in UGM

Over one hundred student activists consisted in BEM of Indonesia (SI) starting on 23rd October to 28th October 2008 will hold the Indonesian Students Conference (KMI). The conference took "From Students for Indonesia: Solution and Contribution for the Nobility of Indonesia" as its theme. The conference was opened by a Talk show that presented the former Constitution Court (MK) of Indonesia Jimly Ashidique and the head of Anti-Corruption Study Center (Pukat) UGM Zainal Arifin Mochtar.

The coordinator of BEM SI, Budiyanto in the midst of the Talk show at the meeting room of University Club (UC) UGM on Thursday (23/10) expected that this annual event can generate alternative solution to various problems in Indonesia. He also added that in the conference there's an idea of Deklarasi Pemuda (Young Generation Declaration).
