The alumnus of Faculty of Law UGM year 1994 added since having been employed at Save the Children, he had been to India, UK, Ireland, Korea and other countries. He also described Save the Children now has a vision to fight for children around the world to enjoy their right to grow as best as possible, to get protection, to participate and survive.

"Multitasking and multidimensional ability is needed at work, especially in the International Organizations," he added.
